Prayer Points: This month we are remembering:

Shooting Star Chase

Shooting Star Chase is a leading children's hospice charity caring for babies, children and young people with life-limiting conditions, and their families. Whether lives are measured in days, weeks, months or years, they are there to make every moment count, by supporting families from diagnosis to end of life and throughout bereavement with a range of nursing, practical, emotional and medical care.



The support is free of charge to families and available 365 days a year. The care service includes a short break at two hospices, Hospice at Home, day care, symptom management, end-of-life care, bereavement care and a comprehensive range of therapies and support groups for the whole family. It costs £9.5 million a year just to maintain the current level of care. Around 10% of that income comes from government funding.

Please pray for: all the volunteers who maintain the gardens at Shooting Star Chase.

Each of the bedrooms at the hospice are set around the garden, with double doors allowing access even if a child is unable to get out of bed. The fun and accessible outside equipment can be enjoyed by children and young people of all abilities.

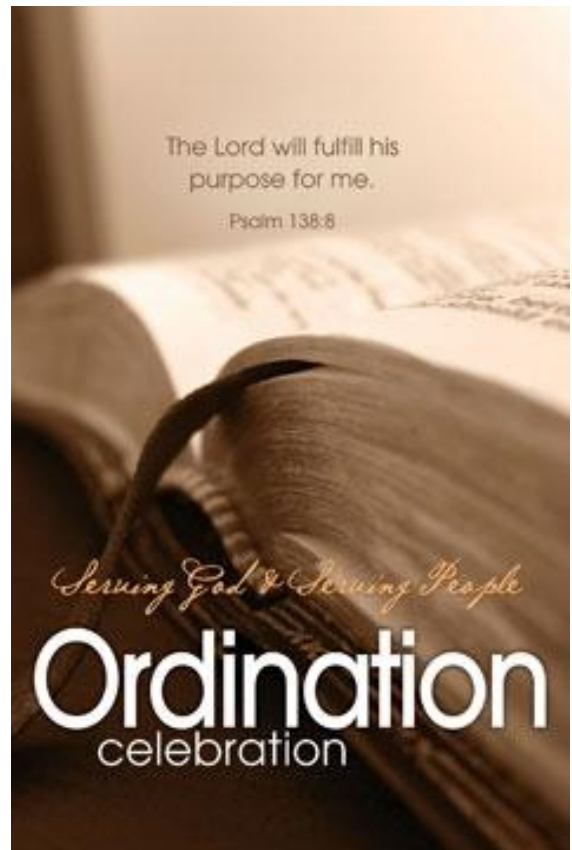
