Electoral Roll 2019 (6 year cycle)

This year is when a new Electoral roll is to be created. The old one will no longer be in force. From today all people wishing to be included on this new roll will have to complete a new application (Form B) and return to the Electoral Roll Officer (Clive Ellam) or to the Parish office by 17th March 2019.

Applications after that date cannot be entered onto the roll until after the APCM on the 11th April.

Anyone who was on the previous roll should have a named envelope containing a new Form B at their church (Holy Trinity or St Columba). Forms can also be obtained from Clive Ellam, the Parish Office, or via your Churchwarden.

If you could possibly ensure you complete the section of whether you live in or out of the Parish and also which church you attend it would really help speed up the process of creating the new roll.
